## 2009 - 2010 MEMBERSHIP CONTEST

The Huntsville Chapter of NCMA is proud to sponsor the Membership Contest for the 2009-2010 program year. The contest will be monitored by the Vice President for Membership and the Membership Committee. It will be the responsibility of all members who participate to see that they are properly registered at each NCMA sponsored event and receive credit for each member they sponsor.

**Objective:**

To improve Chapter Membership for the 2009 - 2010 program year through increased membership involvement, member recognition and service.

**Contest:**

The contest will run from the beginning of the program year through May 20, 2010. Members will get a chance to win a trip to the NCMA World Congress in Ft. Lauderdale, Florida on July 18-21, 2010. One trip will be awarded for four nights, five days to Ft. Lauderdale, Florida (Officers of the Huntsville NCMA Chapter are precluded from participation in the contest). The trip includes airfare allotment, per diem and World Congress registration. The contest will be based on membership participation in all NCMA events from the beginning of our program year through May 20, 2010 (e.g., Monthly luncheons, sponsor a new member, NES events, local NCMA educational events, NCMA audio seminars, National Education Conferences, NCMA community sponsored events).

Each member who participates in one or more of the following activities will be awarded points based on the scale listed below. The winner will be notified by June 1, 2010 and presented the prize at the June 2010 Awards Dinner. Members should provide email notification to Lisa Hubbard the name of each member you sponsored the preceding month. You will then receive credit for that sponsorship.

<b>National Educational Conferences</b>	<b>3 points per attendance</b>
<b>NCMA Sponsored Community Events</b>	<b>3 points per attendance</b>

**Airfare:**

Airfare allotment not to exceed \$400.00 will be reimbursed for transportation to Ft. Lauderdale, Florida.



**Lodging:**

Lodging reimbursement is based on 4 nights at \$134.55 per night inclusive of all taxes for a total of \$538.20.

**Per Diem:**

Per Diem is in accordance with the JTR for Ft. Lauderdale, Florida and will be provided at \$53.25 for two days and \$71.00 for three days at a total of \$319.50 for a total of 5 days.

**NCMA Registration:**

NCMA World Congress registration for the winner will be pre-registered at the group rate and paid by the Huntsville Chapter for a not to exceed of \$1,025.00.
